I built a home studio, recorded a number of my original compositions, and subsequently began to receive airplay on a number of college radio stations. Soon after that, I obtained a position working as a music accompanist at Wesleyan University. My studio expanded to include Korg's M1 Workstation. I then began work on my first full-length CD release, while continuing to write and arrange music. I released my first CD on September 7, 2001. "What's Up Little Man" is dedicated to my Son Terry Woolard Jr. I wanted to give him a gift that he can treasure for the rest of his life. I then upgraded my studio to include the Korg Triton Studio Workstation. On December 19, 2005 I released my second CD "It's All About Love", a more lyrical album, which brought an even greater range of music ideas and production. Since then, I have

purchased the Korg Micro-X ML keyboard. I am presently working on my third album, which should be completed in the Spring of 2008. Over these years, I have steadily performed and toured as a musician. Some of the places I have performed include: The 92 Theatre, Crowell Concert Hall, CFA Studios and The World Music Hall at Wesleyan University, Middletown, CT Hubbard Park, Meriden, CT Bushnell Park, Hartford, CT Radisson Hotel, Hartford, CT The Hartford Ballroom, Hartford, CT The SM, Manila, Philippines The Marriott, Cromwell, CT Many, many Churches throughout the East Coast and Canada.
