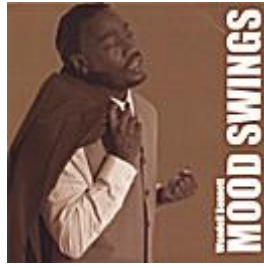


# Mp3 Wendell Bennett - Mood Swings
