"SKAMP" - 1) an abbreviation of the Lithuanian word 'Savas Kampas' which means 'your niche'. 2) a wicked band in Lithuania. Since 1998 SKAMP have reigned as one of the best live acts in Lithuania as well as The Baltic's. They're best known for kick-ass concerts and fusing together various styles of music to create their own eclectic cocktail. Over the years the trio have garnered many awards including Best Debut (1999), Best Band (2000, 2001, 2004) 2005) and Best Album (2000, 2001 2004) while Erica has won "Best Female Artist" (2001 2002) and Vee has won "Best Producer" (2000). While the new video "Reach" currently has
