I would always put my own spin on the melody, he said. At 16, he entered a neighbourhood chant out competition where he was rechristened FIREBALL. The chant out changed my life, he said. Fast-forward to 2006, where Richards had honed his chanting, singing and songwriting talents to a fine point and was beginning to attract attention in his homeland. Richards entered the first edition of Synergy TVs hit show SOCA STAR competition, the top rated tv show which is the Caribbeans equivalent of AMERICAN IDOL. At the tv shows finals, held at the National Stadium, FIREBALL sung his own composition Danger and won the show, becoming the 2006 Soca Star,

effectively launching his career to a new level! FIREBALL hopes the worldwide success of What I Want will help spread the word that Caribbean music and the infectious rhythms of Soca music are undeniable and poised to penetrate the world music scene!
