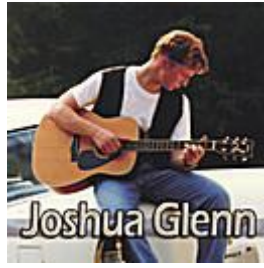


# Mp3 Joshua Glenn - Country: Modern Country
