WORLD: World Fusion, ROCK: Emo Details: Cristina starts her relationship with music from early youth singing in the family environment. Between 1978-1985 she studied, solfege and voice in the Aula de Musica Moderna i Jazz de Barcelona, at the same time that she studied journalisme. From 1985 a 1990 she studied voice, piano and composition at Berklee College of Music (Boston, Mass). She graduated (cum laude) in Composition and Film Scoring. She studies voice with Roberta Davis and Luz Bermejo, (Boston) and Fernando Ba-Barcelona. In Paris she studied composition with Yuli Galperine, (1998). Cristinas background also includes jazz, tango, chanson and latin music. En 1980 she records her first cd with (CBS) Madrid. En 1988 she sings live and in studio in Boston, New England and New York. (1988-1991) Barcelona (1991-1997) and Paris (1997-2000). Back in Barcelona she records Collares enredados (2001) and plays it accompanied by guitar, piano, bass, percussion and accordion. As a singer she collaborates with diferent artists - Gustavo Beytelman, Priscilla Ermel, Cece Giannotti, Eduardo Makaroff, SuperElvis, Terence Trent DARby. Her voice accompannies the image in The Truth about Charlie directed by Jonathan Demme (with Gotan Project)(2003); Also she sings in the TV series Para qu sirve un marido for TVE, directed by Rosa Vergs (1996-97); also in the film Veo veo, directed by Maria Ripoll for TV3 (1994) in the film Lola, from Bigas Luna (1980). Cristina sings with the argentine-parisien group of electronic tango GOTAN PROJECT in the cd La revancha del tango (a milion copies sold, Golden Record in France); Inspiracin-Espiracin (2004) and Luntico (2006). She sings on tour in Europe and EE.UU. (2001-2002) The venues include Olympia of Paris, the Royal Albert Hall of London, the Central Park in New York , the jazz festival of Montreal and Montreux. The spring summer 2006 tours around the world with the representation of Luntico. In duo with Gustavo Beytelman at the piano, she shares a serie of

concerts of tango at: Ronnie Scotts in London, in Spain: clubs in Barcelona, Lrida, Torroella de Montgr and in Ukrania: Club Freedom de Kiev, where the critic said: The best concert of the year, its a pty for who missed it, great spirituality emotion and musical sincerity. Also in duo with Gustavo Llull at the piano, she sings at summer Music Festival of Preveza, Greece (2005) and with Gustavo Battaglia at the guitar at Harlem Jazz Club in Barcelona (2005). In trio this time, with Gustavo Llull and Horacio Fumero on Acoustic Bass at Jamboree Club, Barcelona (april 2006).
