Now I was really busy with two kids and didn't have much time or energy to devote to promotion. I didn't want to be one of those mom's who put their career's ahead of their kids. So, this time, I took even more time off and my music just stayed put. FAST FORWARD to present. The kids are older and I want to share my music with the world. What are my plans now? It's a great time to be an independent artist because of the many opportunities that the Internet provides. I want to give back to a cause or causes that I believe in.
