Paul Davy(lead guitar, vocals) who prior to jamming with Will and Dean had never even heard an Irish song, was a excellent addition to the band. Paul was discovered whilst playing his magical guitar neath an old Oak tree. When Will and Dean saw how many little animals had gathered round to hear his song, they knew he had to become a part of Sligo Creek. Talking him into it is a another long long story...the promise of fame and fortune is what finally convinced him. We hope you enjoy the music. We sure enjoyed making it.
