The percussive rhythms create a rocking groove, while trippy synths rise to the surface to create a wave of electronic sound. KZ constantly pushes the boundaries and attempts to bring something different to the listener with each track. The hard rock and hip-hop influences that move to the forefront thus emphasizing bass, guitars and head-bobbing will grab you throughout with its sharp edge as drum stabs and rising synths distort. Background: KZ always loved the "electric sound" with those bleeps, glitches, grooves and beats that pulse with Techno and Electronica. Techno follows as it is typically melodic and harmonic lines still figure heavily in its definition, artists such as, Fluke, Orbital, Crystal Method, and Chemical Brothers provide inspiration for KZ. Philosophy: The measure of good music is not the amount of gear you have or if you string your own guitar under a tree in a nature preserve.
