When not travelling the world with them, he performs and records as a solo artist giving a different focus to his work and allowing free rein to his creativity and musical ability. 5 years ago he was sought out by Danish Composer Caspar Reiff to write and perform with his unique Tolkien Ensemble the only authorised musical adaptation of The Lord of the Rings. In Fishing up the Moon Nick Keirs unique and very different styles of music are brought together in an inspiring and evocative collection of songs.
