With production from Slouch and Jerry Nova, Born to Ride has given the world a glimpse into the next level of hip-hop. Clever straight forward lyrics and sonically pounding beats, Born to Ride paints a vivid picture of Claw's battle through the pain and struggle of growing up in the streets. After returning to Murdaland and spreading Born to Ride throughout the east coast, Claw returned to Los Angeles to record his second solo album. Billionaire Thug Era is the win-win situation that all urban music listeners have been waiting for. It also reflects a definitive advancement in Claw's styles and lyrical

abilities. Billionaire Thug Era is the perfect balance between commercial and underground. Claw surpasses traditional rapper's capabilities by being both gangsta and sensitive, serious and fun.
