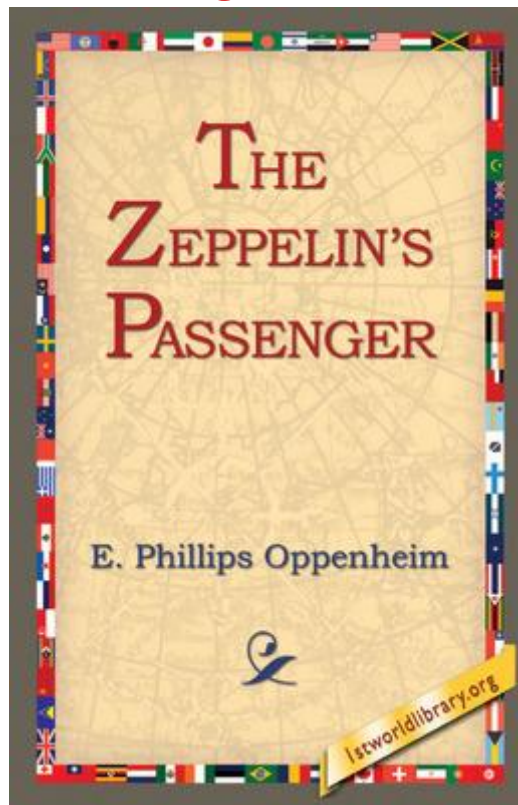


The Zeppelin's Passenger - E. Phillips Oppenheim
