Maggie, Angela and Judith formed Anam Cara early in 2000 because they loved singing the wide variety of harmony songs they were learning in the workshop. They perform their own material as well as arranging and singing songs from different traditions. They have also collaborated with award-winning jazz saxophonist Tony Woods. Anam Cara has performed in colleges, pubs, churches and hospitals; for refugees, patients, discerning listeners and merry drinkers; with saxophonists, cellists, comedians and choirs. Anam Caras first CD, Live at St Georges was released in 2001.
