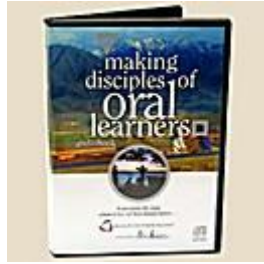

The Issue Group on Making Disciples of Oral Learners was Issue Group No. 25. This group produced Lausanne Occasional Paper (LOP) No. 54 and the next year ION and the Lausanne Committee for World Evangelization released Lausanne Occasional Paper as the book "Making Disciples of Oral Learners".
