Duke Ellington's familiar "Prelude To A Kiss" and "I Let A Song Go Out Of My Heart" contrast his "Day Dream". Rube Bloom's "Can't Face The Music Without Singin' The Blues" and Curtis Lewis' "All Night Long" balance the well-known "Takin' A Chance On Love" and "Our Love is Here To Stay". Adams added lyrics to "That Sunday" by George Weiss Joe Sherman, and wrote the lyrics to "I Want You To Remember", composed by Allan Mueller. Raw Silk was a labor of love and the platform for Patricia learning the recording process.
