Daffy Dave has been voted Number One Children's Entertainer in the Bay Area by the readers of Bay Area Parent Magazine every year since 2000. His silly songs and stories CDs have received positive reviews in The School Library Journal and Booklist Magazine. His TV Show received 2nd Place (out of 14 Children's Television Shows Nationwide) in the 2003 Hometown Video Awards. Dave's CDs and Videos are sold internationally and his Internet Safety Song (written with Larry Magid of SafeKids.com) is downloaded 1,500 times per month. Recently, Dave won The 2005 Children's Music Web Award (childrensmusic.org) for Best Pre-School Songs "The Hop, Hop Song", "Red Light, Green Light!", and Best Classic Recording (children ages 5-8) for "Get Down with the Clown!" His latest CD, "Silly Party Songs" (a Best Hits CD from his first two albums), was just released for digital and general distribution in 2006. Hurry, Fire Truck is sung to the tune of 10 Little Indians and Twinkies, Twinkies, Candy Bars is sung to the tune of Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star.
