Ten rocking numbers layer the formidable talents of Tal Morris (Huey Lewis The News) on lead guitars, Bill Laymon (David Nelson Band, NRPS, etc.) on bass, and the legendary Pete Sears (Hot Tuna, etc) on keyboards accordion, with Julie on rhythm guitars, vocals flute, and Don Bourne on drums. Culled from songs written primarily after APOTHEOSIS, WAKENING captures in the studio the conflicting energies and juxtaposition of strong emotions prevalent in our times. A concept album that shifts energy from negative to positive, WAKENING is exactly what we need in our world-at-large today. Rooted in a myriad of classic rock influences, and combined with rock-solid backing, WAKENING is a shamanic journey to higher energy. From the clever invitation in "Someone Like You", through the hot proposition of "Sweet Thing",

the timely honesty of "Killer Go Home" to the unapologetic anthem "I'm Not Sorry", WAKENING is a great representation of Julie Larson's rapidly evolving talents.

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
