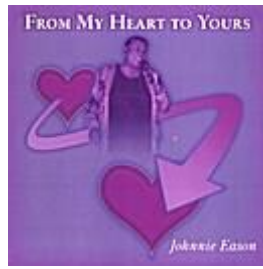

Johnnie Eason is a native of Kansas City, Missouri, where she received her primary and secondary education. She later began singing in the church at the age of five, with her mother's encouragement. She later became the featured soloist and guest soloist in other churches throughout the Mid West and East. A student of The Conservatory Of Music, Ms. Eason became an accomplished traditional jazz vocalist. Her voice is that of smoke and satin, in the reminiscence of Sarah Vaughn, the clarity of Carmen McCrae, the innocence of Gloria Lynn, the smoothness of Nancy Wilson and with the earth sounds of Cissy Houston. The quality and style of her three-octave range is creative, dynamic and soul stirring. It communicates tasteful sensitivity and grace while demanding an emotional response from her audience. Her performances in the United States and abroad include night clubs, supper clubs, jazz and blues festivals, colleges, concert halls, the theater and private functions.
