Two weeks later he met Northwest Arkansas legend, Jed Clampit. After stalking Jed, never missing a performance, Ken developed a friendship with Jed who has become a mentor. "I guess Jed thought if he taught me to play the guitar a little I'd leave him alone. He was wrong, and we've been truest friends ever since. We have a unique bond, and I owe him more than I can ever repay. Jed is responsible for my first gig, the inspiration to write songs, and helping me realize how much I love making music." Over the last nine years while touring solo and with the Jed Clampit Band, Ken has shared the stage with greats like Rock Killough, Sonny Throckmorton, Keith Sykes, Doug Supernaw, James "Jimbo" Mathus, Mississippi Chris Sharp, Ed "Bones" Dye, Clint Jordan, Tate Moore, Bryan Ledford, T-Model Ford, Johnny Barbato, Ken Edwards, Bonepony, Steve Thompson, David Burns, Brad Van Winkle, Andrew Milburn, Chester P, Bruce Parker, Sid Simons, Kim Carson, Jimmy Boggs, Kip Attaway, Will Barrett, Brent Moyer, Jeff Fowlkes, and more.
