There's even a beautiful story-song called "Tyler My Boy" done entirely with a choral background. Here's Pat Rocco doing all his favorite songs (hence the album title) that he's done on stages, nightclubs, television, radio, and cabaret settings throughout his fabulous singing career (which is decidedly NOT over - he made six MORE CD's after this one), all on one amazing CD that you'll enjoy over and over again.
