I have illustrated many books and created many paintings that are used in ads and packages and posters... and I have songs... I express my ideas about life, about relationships, about searching for love and finding it, and mostly about searching for myself. Who am I? At the end of my life I hope I will know. I hope to have evidence through my art and my music. It is a journey that you are now part of and that I express everyday through my art and my music. I am learning
