Roger's musical ideas and technical proficiency matched with Weeks personal and conversational lyrical style made songwriting easy and well rounded. The next step was to find a drummer who shared this same musical chemistry. Weeks and Rogers knew exactly who they wanted and found the perfect match in Derek Hall of the now defunct band Thousand Faces. Derek's skills were legendary in the area and his enthusiasm and love for music and the project was the last piece to the puzzle. dimmer was born. The recent addition of talented guitarist Shane Short has helped bring the dimmer sound to life on stage. With a hybrid sound reminiscent of Toad the Wet Sprocket, Live, and R.E.M., dimmer recently released its first self-produced full length CD Spot You In The Crowd in late 2002. The self-recorded album is already receiving accolades and radio airplay, while the band is playing shows around the southeast in search of new fans.
