She has been chosen to be included in a book about the top 500 jazz vocalists of all time written by Scott Yanow (writer for Down Beat, Jazz Times and AllMusicGuide), to be published in 2005. She has released several CDs with her Contemporary World Jazz ensemble called SIORA (siorajazz.com), which she co-leads with keyboardist/composer Dan Kleiman. Their new CD, called "Vis-a-Vis," was released in 2004. It is a journey in 7 languages of music from around the world expressed through the language of jazz.
