Jo Bredeson gave Richard "Me and Old Grandad", which goes without saying it's pure country roots... and before Johnny Bush did his own version of "Stand By Me", he sent it to Richard for his undeniable signature mark of which only the true pioneers share. Vern Stovall... Don't know the name? You know the accomplishments... he was responsible for giving us Elvis Presley's "Long Black Limosine", and also for giving Charlie Harris "Deepin the Heart of Anne", which he also offered to Rich. But his contribution to this album was "That's My Baby", one of the best waltzes to come along in a good while. Now, for the the title cut, we have to thank Larry Anderson... a San Antone native, and brother to classic country artist Bailey Anderson.
