His teacher learned him to master the powers of Cubase and at the age of 12 was Marcos first song born. In the year 2003, Marco joined forces with Digitally Imported - of which he was an addicted listener - by setting up a Chillout channel on their site. He started to play his own songs on the channel and received a wave of positive comments. At the end of 2004, Marco decided to release his first album Steam. This album was released in May 2005, which was also the birth of his record label Cardamar Music. The other side of Cardamar (as DJ) was born in 2000. He became interested in DJing trance music, and made numerous mixes in this style. From 2003, Marco focused completely on doing Chillout mixes. Another Day In The Clouds was the first Chillout mix which could be heard on Digitally Importeds Chillout channel. It received some great feedback, and soon, more of his mixes appeared on the Chillout playlist. This also resulted in some collaboration mixes with artists like Morlack, Kick Bong and Xerxes.
