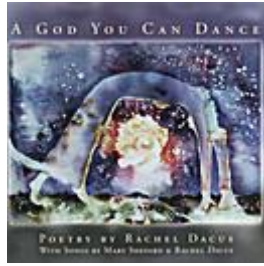


Mp3 Rachel Dacus - A God You Can Dance

Details: Rachel Dacus's poetry and lyrics interpreted dramatically, with sound effects and music, combine to create an hour's stress-releasing, whimsical meditation. The CD includes group and individual readings and four songs, taking the listener into the shining core of the everyday. The poetry reveals a special sparkle of divinity glinting not just in the obvious places, but at an auto repair shop, a ballet class, and tucked inside a purse. A God You Can Dance takes the listener through a constantly changing aural landscape for a program as varied and refreshing as summer weather. Listen to it while commuting, cooking, or on a walk.
