Recently they have been busy in the studio, and in addition to their own long-awaited CD release Surfing the Magma will be appearing on compilation CDs both for LAs Golly Gee Records and Spains OmOm records. Their new release is the culmination of a years worth of songwriting and months of trying out these songs in clubs up and down the California coast. Bill Bergstrom fronts the band, and his arsenal of guitars attracts almost as much attention as he does. Kenan OBrien, the ever-solid bass player lays down the foundation for Bill to jump from, all while finding the darkest corner of the stage to stand in. The red-faced drummer is Taylor Still, an accomplished drummer and percussionist, who rounds out the band by providing the solid beat and his own flair, all the while driving the band with straight-ahead surf chops.

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
