His modest budget means Atwood does it all himself, but the sound of Blessed Be is quite good and will amaze fans of mid "'70s" progressive rock. Written, preformed, mixed and produced by the artist, the CD makes fine use of Atwood's electric guitars, synths and percussion and the sound is filled with the opulent, symphonic strains of melodic art-rock instrumentals. Atwood defies the odds and comes up with a fine album with Blessed Be.
