


Mp3 Eric Caboor / David Kauffman - Beyond The Blue

Even though "Beyond The Blue" is not the long-awaited successor to 1992's "Tight Rope Town", it's at least the overdue re-release of their rare second album, made in 1989, and only distributed locally in its original vinyl edition. The two multi-instrumentalists employed three guest musicians for this production: the great Leo LeBlanc (pedal steel), John Keene (accordion) and "Phlim" Flambeau (drums). (Caboor and Kauffman) are sharp observers, having a knack for writing about the specialness of the ordinary. This talent has earned them favorable comparisons to Robbie Robertson, Bruce Cockburn, T-Bone Burnett, and David Baerwald. "Beyond The Blue" breathes the spirit of a classic Southern California folk-rock/country-rock production, with up tempo numbers and countrified ballads coming together in a relaxed, but still forceful record. ("Beyond The Blue") was more than just a warmup for "Tight Rope Town"! TAXIM
