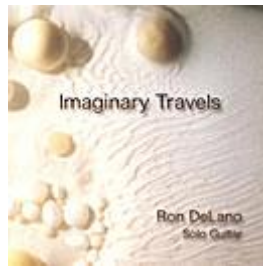

Imaginary Travels recorded in 2002. A beautiful and very haunting collection of 14 original songs

composed by Ron DeLano. His style of playing pin points accuracy within the structures and a warmth

music from different countries (some real and some imagined) rendered in the virtuoso style of the

pioneering "New Age" guitarists of the last couple of decades. The music is clean and pure solo steel

string acoustic guitar using a combination of standard and open tunings. The piece Midnight Dunes

evokes middle eastern music, Rising Sun is Japanese in flavor and Wild Turkey is distinctly bluegrass. These pieces are interspersed with works more in the New Age genre. Recording: Great care was taken to produce a polished quality result at every step in the process. The music was performed on a fine Charles Fox guitar made with cocobolo wood and which has beautiful tone. This style of guitar playing (open string played against high fretted notes) requires uncompromising intonation and the Charles Fox guitar was the best found found anywhere. charlesfoxguitars.com The fifteen pieces were digitally recorded in the winter of 2002 at Spirit Bear Studios, Hood River, Oregon. A couple tracts have the added color of percussion accompaniment. The recordings were then professionally mastered by Mark Frethem of Dr. Digital in Portland Oregon and duplicated by Crave Dog Records. In addition, all selections have been transcribed in standard notation and tablature using Encore for future publication of an accompanying sheet music book. This is Ron's second CD release. Artist: Ron DeLano is well versed in a variety of musical genres including rock, jazz and classical. He studied classical guitar at USC, played string bass in the Grand Junction Symphony for over a decade and plays piano. He has been in high demand as a string bassist in the Northwest in a variety of groups from singer songwriter Ivy Rose, Gipsie Ale and the presently with the popular regional vintage swing and jazz group Django's Cadillac. He has been featured as a string bassist in several CD projects. Composition has always been his true love and Imaginary Travels is the culmination of this effort. The music is respectful of the listener while attempting to find a unique voice in the less traveled world of solo acoustic guitar. The artist finds that the difficulty of writing a polyphonic piece for solo guitar imposes a discipline that provides both challenges and rewards.
