

In her hula classes, she shares her love of Hawaiian culture and she really enjoys performing with her students. Kamalani was written by Leilanis father, Larry Rivera, who also recorded the song. The selection is dedicated by Leilani to her first-born daughter, Kamalani. The translation of the title of her album is, The Works of Love. 4. TURTLE BAY RUM Kaala (Anela Kahiamoe) 3:22 Kaala, a duo consisting of Franny Villareal Anela Kahiamoe, were performing in the lobby bar of the Turtle Bay Resort. They had a very pleasing laid-back style and so we stopped to listen. We liked their sound and said, Someday well do something with you folks. Well, today is the day! As you listen, pretend youre joining us on a warm Hawaiian evening wearing a flower lei and sipping on Turtle Bay Rum. 5. MAUI,

They live and work on The Valley Isle of Maui, so its natural that they would sing a tune about home. WAIMEA Cory Oliveros (Aaron Kimura) 4:06 Cory Oliveros can be seen and heard performing in and around Honolulu. This song, from his first solo project, features Wayne Wakai on alto sax and has a very contemporary groove as he sings the praises of Waimeas harmony with nature, the sand and the sea. Teresa recorded it on her 1990 Self Portrait release and her version receives requests every week. The steel guitar solo features another Hawaiian legend, Eddie Palama. UKULELE BOOGIE Brittni Paiva (Brittni Paiva) 2:14 Brittni Paiva is a very talented young lady from Hilo, Hawaii who began recording in early 2005 at age 15. Brittni won a Na Hoku Hanohano Award as the most promising artist of the year (2005) for her first album, Brittni X 3. The 3 refers to the fact that she played bass, slack key guitar and ukulele on the album. This song is from her second album titled, HEAR... It features Wendell Ching on drums, and Brittni on everything else. brittnipaiva.com 9. MOLOKAI HOE Na Kama Hele (Peter Apo) 3:01 Na Kama Hele combines both Hawaiians and Hawaiians at heart on this island chart-topper. Peter Apos mele (song) tells the story of one of Hawaiis great canoe races which starts on the island of Molokai and finishes some 41 miles away on the island of Oahu. nakamahele.com 10. MY HAWAII Scott Katsura (Scott Katsura) 4:51 Scott Katsura sings No words can describe whats felt in my heart. This updated version of My Hawaii was taken from his award-winning album, Aloha Miles Away which won the Hawaii Music Award (2005, Pop Album of the Year). Kaaihue) 3:59 PALI is an award-winning group that performs all over Hawaii. They were awarded a Hawaii Music Award (2005, Contemporary Album of the Year) for their album, In Harmony. The introduction to this original mele (song) is performed by slack key guitar master, John Keawe, who continues to provide a solid backing for PALI as they tell us about Island Days. pali.net 12. Kamae Larry Kimura) 3:41 Kuuipo Kumukahi, often called the sweetheart of Hawaiian music, has been part of Aloha Radios rotation since day one (1994).
