
Piccadilly Jim - P. G. Wodehouse

The residence of Mr. Peter Pett, the well-known financier, on Riverside Drive is one of the leading eyesores of that breezy and expensive boulevard. Architects, confronted with it, reel and throw up their hands defensively, and even the lay observer has a sense of shock.
