Amanda prides herself in her all-star band, Aaron Parks/piano, Keith Ganz/guitar, Peter Slavov/bass and Kendrick Scott/drums. Keith Ganz mixed the album and it was mastered at DB Studios in New York. Tal Goretsky designed the CD jacket cover and Aram Jibilian took the photos. A short history of Amanda: Born in Santa Cruz California. Graduated from Fremont High School as an aspiring Chemical Engineer. During her second year at UC Davis she joined The Irradicats, a nine piece Jazz/Swing/Ska band. Realizing that she wanted to pursue a career in music she moved to the east coast and received her undergraduate degree at Berklee College of Music in Boston, performing all around New England to pay the rent. Amanda sang with a wedding and general business band called Airtight. She also sang on the Odyssey Cruise Ship and with her own jazz quartet.
