From sweet, soulful ballads to deep blues, blues rock and swinging Texas shuffles, Loaded Dice has all the blues bases covered. Superlative vocals blend with hot guitar and harp with a dose of boogie-woogie piano thrown in for good measure. 15 MP3 Songs BLUES: Electric Blues, BLUES: Blues Vocals Details: The aptly titled You Gotta Roll, is packed with a full 65 minutes of seasoned electric blues music, much of it written by the band. Of the disc's 15 cuts, 11 are originals and show Loaded Dice's versatility in handling everything from plaintive ballads to Texas shuffles to up-tempo blues rockers. Guitarist Mark Schwerin has a hand in all of the disc's 11 original tunes, with vocalist Marci Linn co-writing seven cuts. Harmonica ace and vocalist Joe Ferguson contributes to two of the songs. "What separates this from the run of the mill "local release" is the strength of the original material - eleven of the disc's fifteen cuts - in which they have taken that major step into defining their own sound. Tight arrangements and killer vocal harmonies and most importantly knowing what notes not to play, make it a pleasure to listen to. The four "covers" are not the overplayed standards. Johnny Copeland's "Cut Off My Right Arm," is right on the money! The other three range from Earl King to the Rolling Stones to Lou Ann Barton. Loaded Dice formed in January 1993 and since then has played

regularly across southwest Michigan at numerous festivals, clubs and special events. Loaded Dice has opened shows for Smokey Wilson, Buddy Guy, Big Daddy Kinsey, Lonnie Brooks, Long John Hunter and Lil' Ed and the Blues Imperials. Known for superlative vocals and rock-solid musicianship, Loaded Dice's reputation has spread across Michigan and the Midwest. An "unplugged" version of the band released a self-titled CD in 1998, earning glowing reviews in several national publications including Blues Revue and Blues Access.
