Bruce Springsteen has been known to even jump on stage occasionally. Live rock and roll 4 nights a week, and lots of other types of music also. Doug still plays music, and has recently released a cd entitled "Adrift". Lots of different styles make up this collection. From irish to jazz, I think you will enjoy Doug's music.
