she often volunteers to entertain at several Senior Day Care Centers. She also performs at a number of rehabilitation, assisted living and independent living facilities. I have seen the response to her voice, and the love it emits brings light and animation to eyes that were only pools of quiet darkness. I have often watched in amazement as these people get out of their chairs to dance, clap, laugh and even to cry, on occasion. Musical theater has always had a special place on Julie's list of professional priorities, and she has performed and directed on stages in two continents. "The King and I," and "Promises, Promises" are two of the productions in which she played leading roles. She has entertained audiences in Nevada, Hawaii, Florida and South America, in English and Spanish. Julie says, "A musical performance is not a 'job' that can be done for the sole purpose of making a living. One must have a sincere love for music and for people to make a performance memorable."
