His music is well loved across the region. He is known as one of the greatest African guitarists, appointed the title "Maestro" by his fans. He is an innovator, a prolific composeur and a true artist. His unique 12 string acoustic guitar performance is featured on this album. He sucessfully toured with his own group "Zaita Musica" to Europe in 1991 and has continuously performs as a solo guitarist as well as with his colleagues - Nguza Viking, King Kiki, Kassongo Mpinda Clayton, Kibambe Rhamadhan, Delphin Mununga, and others on multiple nights a week in various Dar es Salaam clubs.
