

Robin takes on every topic with intelligence, detail and wit, from original sin on the title track, "Gardener Of Eden" to an exploration of the mind of Janis Joplin on the haunting rock ballad, "Comfort". The wit should come as no surprise. Robin has appeared on Comedy Central's "Out There In Hollywood", Showtime's "In Through the Out Door" and performed her one woman show "Kickin' Hard" to sold out houses at The HBO Workspace in Los Angeles.
