She had her first taste of the stage at age 5, performing in a ballet and singing for an audience of loving parents and friends. At 36 Sharla had met someone on The East coast and decided to move to the greater Washington D.C. area. There, Sharla had the opportunity to perform in front of large crowds exceeding 20,000. And again, the response was very positive. At this time she had no material to market and wanted to begin recording. It wasn't until she moved to Arizona 2 years later, that Sharla finally was able to make this dream come true. Sharla sought out a local producer and began to lay down the tracks to "The Road Of Life" Her first CD and not her last. Sharla Shore finds her inspiration from many sources. One reason for writing her music is the environment. "I think it's part of my mission here in life to help heal the Earth and the people on it. I want to help raise awareness of this. This is the only Earth we have. We must take care of it." But Sharla's musical mission doesn't end with the environment. She also wants to help people take control of their lives. Her approach to love and relationships reflects her experience as a surfer. " I write songs to take action. It is not my style to write songs complaining about love or situations people are in. I say, if you're not happy, do something about it." Just as a surfer she would not let a wipe out get the best of her, Sharla refuses to play the victim and opts to take control of her life. The realistic approach to life Sharla Shore exhibits keeps audiences entertained and touched.
