But at that time I chose to do something else - and I ended up spending a lot of time raising kids, fixing houses, growing tomatoes and teaching!" What now? "Well this is just the beginning of a whole new chapter. There's a lot more where these songs have come from and I am looking forward to it like waking up to a brand new day." "At night I close my eyes and step into the street. Im in my sleep and in this town, Which as a child was everything. The mystery of
