Dave Bauer, electric guitar, will pretty near play anything with strings on it and for sure as hell tear your heart out with his Telecaster. Pete Loughlin has years buried in the Canadian road experience as a rock showboat. He's a shocking multi-instrumentalist and picks up the Bass and Harmony Vocals with unequalled ease. Tim Williams is a transplanted Vancouverite that sparks up the Kit with all the fire of the traditional heartbeat. Charlie Hase is the latest addition to the mix. Charlie kicks into the Double Neck Steel and Lap Slide with unparalleled expertise and all the country charm of a moon-eyed banshee. "I truly am in awe every time I stand on stage with these guys.
