Short stories is the first solo CD recorded entirely at Homer's Higher Ground Music studio in Hurst, Texas. The CD features a collection of 11 songs written over a span of ten years. "I had other newer stuff written, but these are a few songs that I've been wanting to do for a while". "Plus drumming was new to me and I had to select songs that I felt I could play well enough". The 11 songs on the CD reflect a variety of Homer's influences ranging from The Beatles, Bob Marley, The Eagles, Harry Nilsson, and Led Zeppelin.
