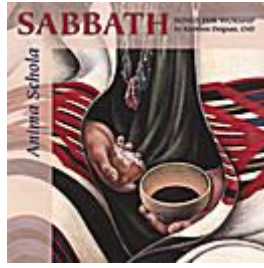


Mp3 Kathleen Deignan - Sabbath: Songs For Worship

Many thanks to the members of Anima Schola, past and present, who bring the songs of my humble composition to a beautiful richness each Sabbath, and have done so for several decades. I dedicate these songs to them and to the community of the Benedictine Grange. In particular I salute Fr. John Giuliani whose icon, Navajo Christ Breaking Bread, beautifully mirrors the way his own faithful hands have blessed and broken the Bread of Life with and for us these many decades. I am delighted it graces the album and this book of songs. We invite you to hear our realization of this music on our recording Sabbath, where each member of our ensemble interpreted particular songs in their own voice and style. The result is a refreshing novelty and variety of a repertoire that we hope will re-sound beyond the rafters of our Sabbath place.
