Debbie Tharpe-Fennell is featured with Roberson and LIFE on the head bobbing, foot stomping, hand clapping, back home Mountain Move. Robersons convincing mix of traditional and contemporary gospel -(good news) leaves one with a desire to dance on Intro and jam with Jesus on I Owe You. Pentecost provides us with the confidence to face and overcome any challenge while the very sensual We Need Love soulfully links us to each other. Indigenous to Long Island, Jeff Robersons tantalizing tenor testifies in My Joy, ranging in a duet with 2006 McDonalds Gospel fest winner, Bettina Pennon, another talented Long Islander. Likewise, we can feel Roberson when he delivers his heart wrenching testimony and witness on the very intimate, I Believe. Accompanied by his keyboard and sympathetic strings, he clearly crystallizes, his pain, hope, and resilience, asking and convincingly answering that age old question

What is the meaning of life?
