routines for state fairs, festivals and talent shows where I was invited to perform. Having experienced great success with my music at various state-sponsored events, I decided to record my first CD, entitled "All I Want," in 2000 at a recording studio near my home town, which was composed entirely of my own original songs. My first release, "Hero," reached number one on Indie Tracker, and my follow-up single, "Caught Me Lookin'," climbed to number one on Inside Country. My third release, "All I Want," reached number three on Indie World charts. "Chuga Choo Choo" reached number one on Indie World charts in 2003, as well, and continues to receive airplay. During this time, I also maintained my role as owner and operator of Kelly's Academy of Dance in my hometown where I taught Ballet, Jazz, Modern and Tap. While I truly loved being a dance instructor, I realized that if I really intended to pursue a career as a country music singer, I would have to make a conscious decision to move, not only whole-heartedly, but also geographically, toward it. Only in Nashville could I immerse myself in the country music industry, which is where I intend to remain until I've achieved what I've come here to do.
