Her performances for many audiences provided an opportunity to work with producers in Detroit, Michigan where Yatron began working on her debut R&B album, of which she was both songwriter and co-producer. Though this project was complete and ready to be released, Yatron realized her heart was in singing Gospel and she decided to pursue a gospel music career. Yatron became a member of Unity Cathedral of Faith Detroit, Michigan, where she was a featured soloist on Bishop Clarence Haddon's debut album. Since then, Yatron has performed in many concerts around the country, including a performance in the Hampton University's Annual Ministers' Conference Richmond, VA as a lead vocalist for a for a congregation of over 10,000. This resulted in multiple invitations for Yatron to sing at churches from the east coast to the west coast and has left many awaiting her debut Gospel release. Yatron currently ministers as the worship leader of her husband's church, Higher Praise and Worship, Colorado Springs, CO and has recently completed her debut Gospel project entitled "Just Believe."
