The songs that flood him with what he calls "that deep blue sensation". "It's like infatuation," he said "like when moonlight falls...I don't know how to describe it." A few years ago he moved to the city to find other like-minded individuals who would join him in his quest for creating dreamy indie-pop music. People like him who dress slightly off and wear confused hair as a matter of pride.
