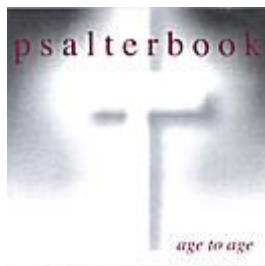

But in doing so, they realized they wanted to create "...a group with a difference, not just a Christian-song cover band". Since their beginnings as a quintet with the exceptional talents of Jeff Garrett

(bass and guitar), Dave Matre (vocals), Jeff Petach (guitar and mandolin), Steve Aldredge (keyboards), and Lori McDonough (flute), psalterbook has expanded to include Matt Frazer (percussion), Sarah Crannell (vocals), Milan Dukic (violin), and, though not featured on this recording, our most recent addition, Christy Thomas harp). Most of psalterbook's members have trained at some of the world's leading conservatories. On 'age to age' psalterbook is grateful to have been joined by world-class guest musicians Deborah Netanel (cello), Miriam Kramer (violin). Psalterbook's sound is an engaging blend of contemporary, folk, bluegrass, celtic, and classical styles. This CD, psalterbook's debut recording, includes everything from "bluegrass-ified" 16th century chant to original creations and appalachian lullabies; from richly-textured lyricism to hair-raising virtuoso instrumentals.
