At age of 6 he started piano lessons, at age of 7 - vocal lessons in great Russian professors BORIS TEVLIN and KLAUDI PTITSA classes. In 1963 he performed in Kremlin, Bolshoi Theater and other famous stages in Moscow with Symphony Orchestra conducted by EMIL KHATCHATURIAN. 1968-1970 he is a soloist of very first in Georgia junior orchestra called "MERTSKHALI". 1971-1978 he is a soloist of Georgian State Univercity Orchestra (Conductors: ENRY LOLASHVILI, NUGZAR EDILASHVILI and BORIS TBILELI. In 1978 he performed like a soloist in Pitsunda Festival with Georgian TV and Radio Orchestra (Conductor - TENGIZ JAIANI). 1979-1990 he

plays with different musicians in Georgia and Europe. 1990-1991 - member of group called "OAZIS".

1994-1998 - member of group called "RES INTEGRA". 2000-2004 - he is working on personal experimental musical projects "SECOND VISION" and Rock symphony "MIDDAY STROLL". 2005 - New Album called "Life Fields".
