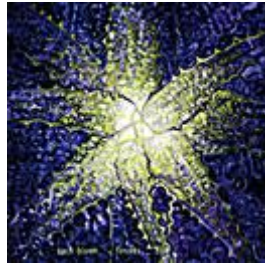

His music covers a broad spectrum, ranging from minimalist ambient to industrial styles. While Bloom's recordings are electronic in nature, his influences range from very ancient to very modern, and his work expresses his belief that the two aren't as different as we often imagine. His inspiration comes from the interaction between the expanse of nature and the confines of the urban life. Zach Bloom's music is infused with the sounds he records in the desert, giving it an organic feeling that pulses like a web of life. His music is designed to represent the interconnectedness of all life on the planet. As a painter and sculptor, Zach embeds in his music a colorful, visual quality. Working primarily in oil paints, he finds that he works with light in much the same way as he does with sound. Fossils, which is Bloom's debut, ranges from ambient to industrial influences, using intricate sampling of natural elements to create deep acoustic worlds. Fossils has been described as "a sonic M.C. Escher tessellation." The early 20th century graphic artist used geometric forms to demonstrate the interaction of plants and animals in their environment. In much the same way, Zach Bloom uses sound to evoke visual patterns and vivid colors. Meant for deep creative states, waking up, long hours at work or times when ambient yet engaging rhythmic music is desired, this recording is perfect. Fossils is a truly visionary recording, complete with holistic album art also created by Zach Bloom.
